Education Full Text: Brings you comprehensive coverage of an international range of English-language periodicals, monographs and yearbooks. Full text of articles, with indexing cover to cover, from hundreds of journals, makes this a one-stop source for research. Coverage includes about 79 journals (37 with full text) not covered by ERIC's CIJE.

ERIC: This is the world's largest source of education information, with more than 1 million abstracts of documents and journal articles on education research and practice. The *AskERIC Virtual Library* contains selected educational resources, including lesson plans.

Professional Collection: Provides access to academic journals and other reference content for educators. The database offers balanced coverage for any professional educator or user interested in professional development.
