



# What Does a Typical Class Schedule Look Like?

This indicates the semester and year that this schedule is for.  
FA= Fall  
SP= Spring

This is the location of the class. The letter indicates which building the class meets in. The number indicates which room within that building the class meets in. A list of buildings and their abbreviations is online for you; just use the link above! Contact the course instructor or Registrar if you have any questions!

This is the section of a class you're in. The section is either a single letter of the alphabet, like it is here, or "S1" or "S2." Often, UT Southern offers multiple options of the same class at different times, so the Section number indicates which one you are in!

This is the title of the course. It may be abbreviated on your schedule, but you can check the Course Catalog online to get the full title and description!

These are the days that this course meets. Any single fetter indicates that the course only meets one day per week.

This is the type of class it is. LEC = Lecture (a standard classroom setting where a professor instructs to a classroom) LAB= Lab (a more hands-on setting) HON= Honors (see Catalog for more information on Honors classes)

This is the Course Number/ID. The first part consists of letters that indicate what academic department the course is in. The second part consists of numbers that indicate which class in the department this is. BOTH the letters and numbers together are the Course Number/ID.

This is the instructor's name. If this field is blank or says TBA or TBD, the instructor has not yet been assigned. Contact the Registrar for more information.

The first and last date of the part of term, although your class may not meet on exactly those days depending on the day of the week it meets. Session 1 (S1) and Session 2 (S2) classes will list their dates, which are different than the full semester. Note that S1 and S2 classes occur in the same semester. For example, if you have an S2 class in the FA (Fall) semester, that doesn't mean it's in Spring-it means it's in the latter half of the FA semester!
